

Now Available at a Computer Near You...

ICA is pleased to announce that the new arrangement with CEU.com to provide testing services for the ICA claims education courses has been in effect since January 1, 2007. Within the first month alone, there were 67 students that registered for exams on CEU.com. The new system is designed to make testing more convenient and cost efficient for students. If the positive feedback received at headquarters is any indication of the success of the program, the ICA Claims Education Program is well on its way to new levels of success!

If you have not yet enrolled for an exam on CEU.com here are a few reminders to help you get started:



1. No System Requirements

CEU.com's system poses no potential security threats therefore firewalls and ActiveX controls do not need to be altered. There should be no issues for ICA students to access the exam webpage from any computer because it is simply an HTML page. All technical questions can be answered by calling CEU.com at 800 295-9010.

2. Proctor Form

Ed. Reps who will be proctoring exams do not have to set up an account in order to proctor exams. They simply need to complete and sign the provided Proctor Form once a student successfully passes an exam. Instructions are provided on each Proctor Form.

3. Payment Options

CEU.com does not issue invoices. Students must pay the \$80 exam fee before they are allowed access to the exam. They have the option of paying for the exam online with a credit card or mailing CEU.com a check. If a check is mailed, the student will not be able to access the exam until CEU.com receives the payment. Group enrollments (10 or more) can be arranged by contacting CEU.com directly at 800 295-9010. Group enrollments can be paid by check or credit card. Please note that CEU.com does not invoice for individual or group enrollments.

4. Student Records

ICA headquarters is currently in the process of updating its database to include all student records. At the end of every month, ICA will receive the student's exam results from CEU.com. Students may then call and receive their course history information upon request. This information will NOT be available online to be accessed individually by the Ed. Reps or students. Ed. Reps will only be able to receive exam results in cases of group enrollments originally made by the Ed. Rep. ICA is not permitted to release exam results made by individual student enrollments to Ed. Reps.
