### ICA Law Enforcement Inquiry (LEI) Program

The LEI service offers to the law enforcement community a service whereby any law enforcement officer can request a canvass of ICA member companies to determine if there is a life insurance policy on a particular individual. These searches have in the past provided useful information in determining if a life insurance policy may be the motive for the death or disappearance of an individual. *Available to ICA member companies only.*
